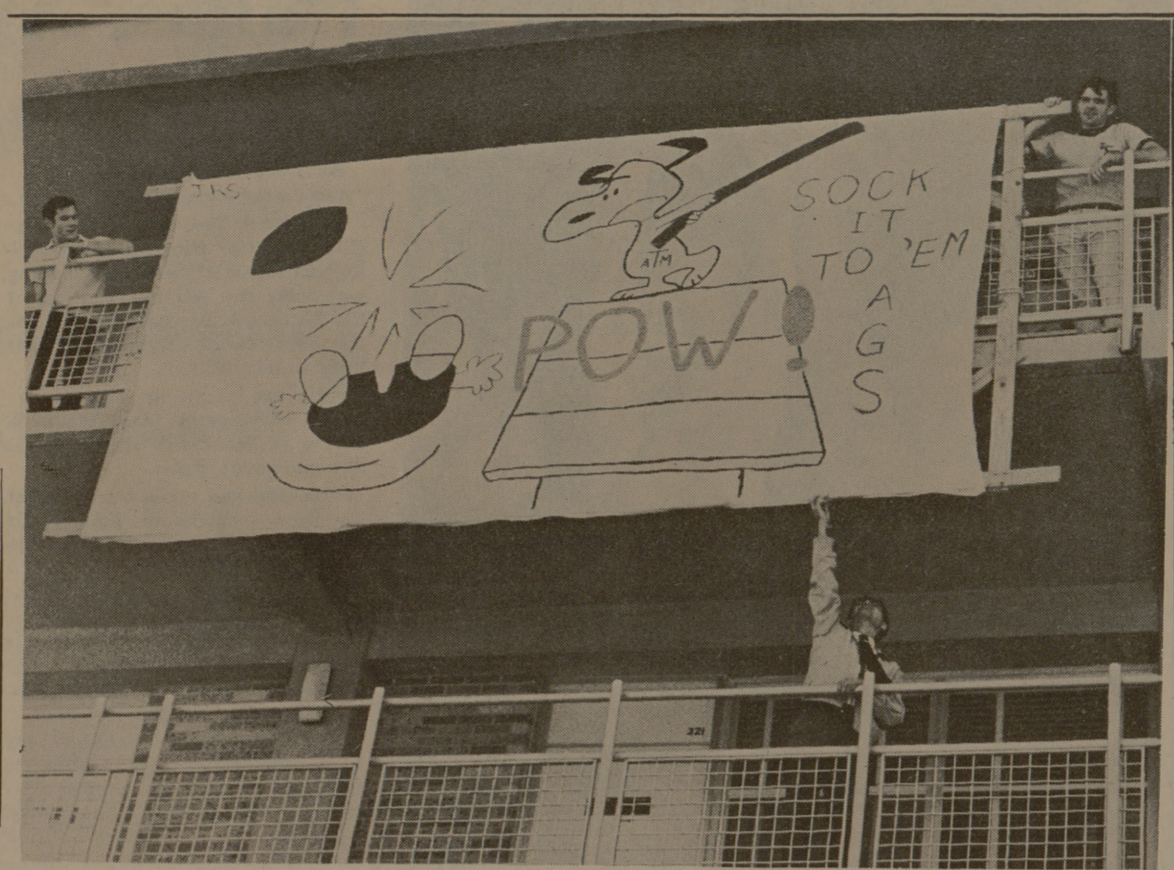


**Iranian Students Elect Officers**

**Education Practices Cited**

Seven new innovative practices in teacher education in use here have been cited by the Texas Education Agency. The programs were listed with 17 others in TEA's October, 1968, publication, "New and Innovative Practices in Teacher Education." Distribution of the 27-page brochure was to the presidents, deans, department heads and professors of education in Texas, according to Dr. Frank Hubert, Liberal Arts dean and acting head of the Education Department.

Programs included are from A&M, Midwestern, North Texas State, Texas A&I and St. Thomas Universities, Austin, Dominican, Incarnate Word, Our Lady of the Lake and Texas Tech Colleges.

Among A&M programs listed is the professional senior semester cited last spring by the American Association of Colleges of Teacher Education. The senior semester is supervised by Dr. Roger L. Harrell, secondary education chairman. Others include improvement of teaching methods, Dr. Jerry Salek, student teaching director, and Dr. Glenn Johnson, undergraduate elementary education chairman; beginning administrators institute, Dr. L. S. Richardson, educational administration chairman; intercultural education through Programa de Educacion Interamericana, Dr. Earl Jones, director; blackboard-by-wire instruction, Creative Application of Technology to Education (CATE) Center, Dr. Thomas J. Moffett, director; teaching disadvantaged, Dr. William H. Graves, graduate elementary education chairman; elementary teaching simulation, Johnson; micro-teaching strategy, and the Agricultural Education Department's teaching materials center, coordinated by Prof. John W. Holcomb.
