Owen Trust Fund **Establishes First Academic Chair**

A trust valued at more than \$500,000 has been established here by the late Dr. Arthur George Owen of Houston and his wife, university officials announced Wednesday.

The university revealed establishment of the Arthur George and Mary Emolene Owen Trust Fund following Dr. Owen's death Saturday.

Dorsey McCrory, development director, said the trust, which includes stocks, bonds and real estate, will be used to establish the university's first privatelyendowed academic chair, in mathematics.

Income from the trust, however, is reserved for life for Mrs. Owen, McCrory noted.
