SLAVE LABOR

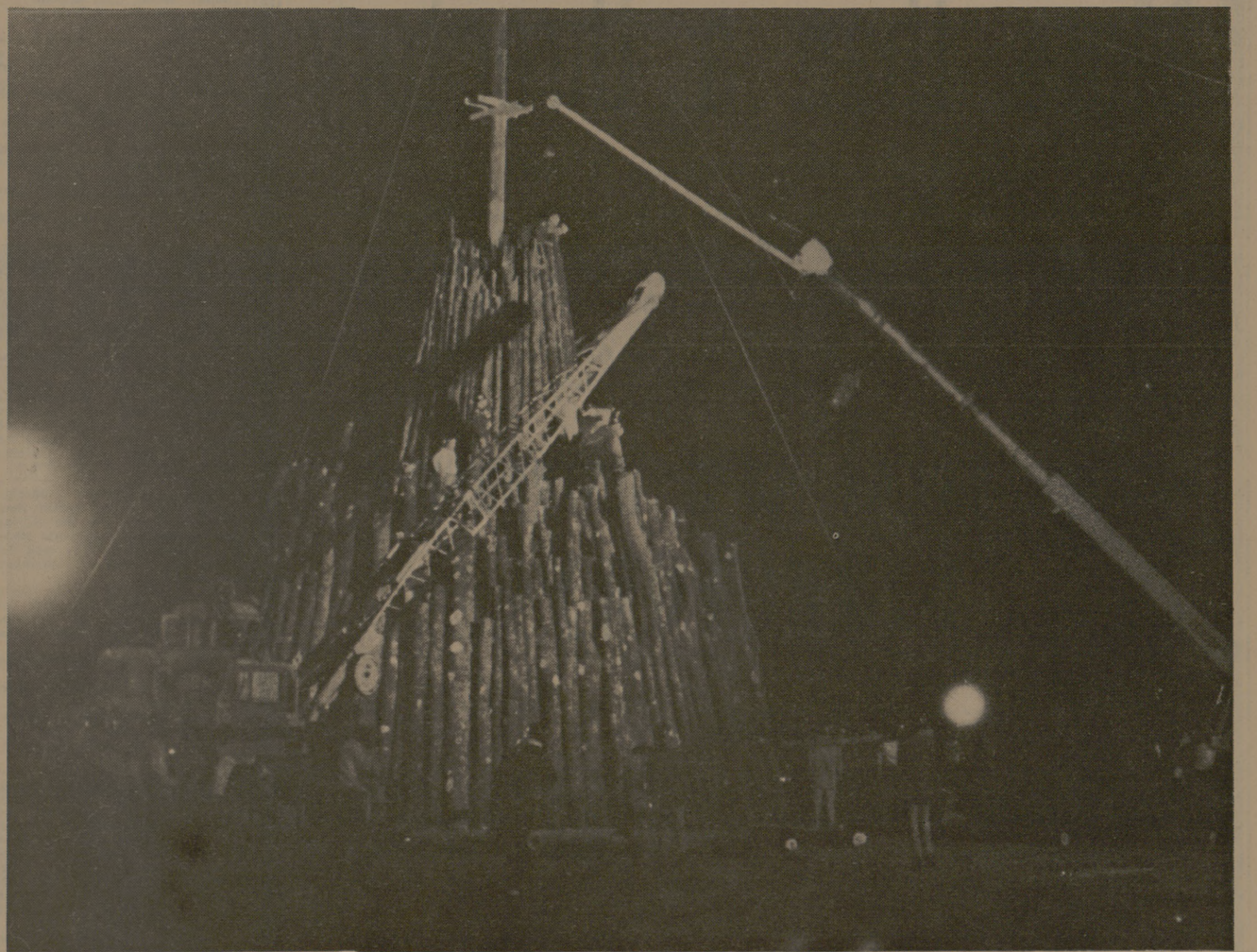
