

Constable School Planned At A&M For March 17-19

A three-day Justice of the Peace and Constable School will be held here March 17-19, Ira E. Scott announced this week.

Scott, head of the Police Training Division here, said the seminar-type program is "designed for all judges and officers" interested in the specific subject material to be presented.

It is sponsored by the Texas Engineering Extension Service. Sessions will be held in the Memorial Student Center from 8 a.m. to 5:30 p.m.

Scott pointed out the annual school will feature several top personalities in law enforcement. Speakers and their topics include:

Carol Vance, Harris County district attorney, misdemeanor and felony bonds.

John Forbes, JP, Arlington,

jury trial procedures in criminal and civil cases in justice court.

JOE B. BROWN JR., JP, Dallas, new laws on landlord and tenant (forcible detainers).

Bill McConnell, Texas Department of Public Safety, Fort Worth, new driver license law.

Jim Bundage, Texas Liquor Control Board, Bryan, the constable in enforcement of Texas Liquor Control Act.

Judge B. H. Dewey Jr., Bryan, JP civil powers duties and procedures.

Norman Suarez, general counsel, Texas Department of Public Safety, Austin, police demand order—Motor Vehicle Inspection.

Scott added, the annual school, held in cooperation with the Justice of the Peace and Constable Association of Texas, helps

keep personnel abreast of changes and procedures in the law.

He called attention to two new laws on driver licensing and landlord-tenant relationships, often processed by the justice court on a local basis.

Participation will be by pre-registration, Scott said.
