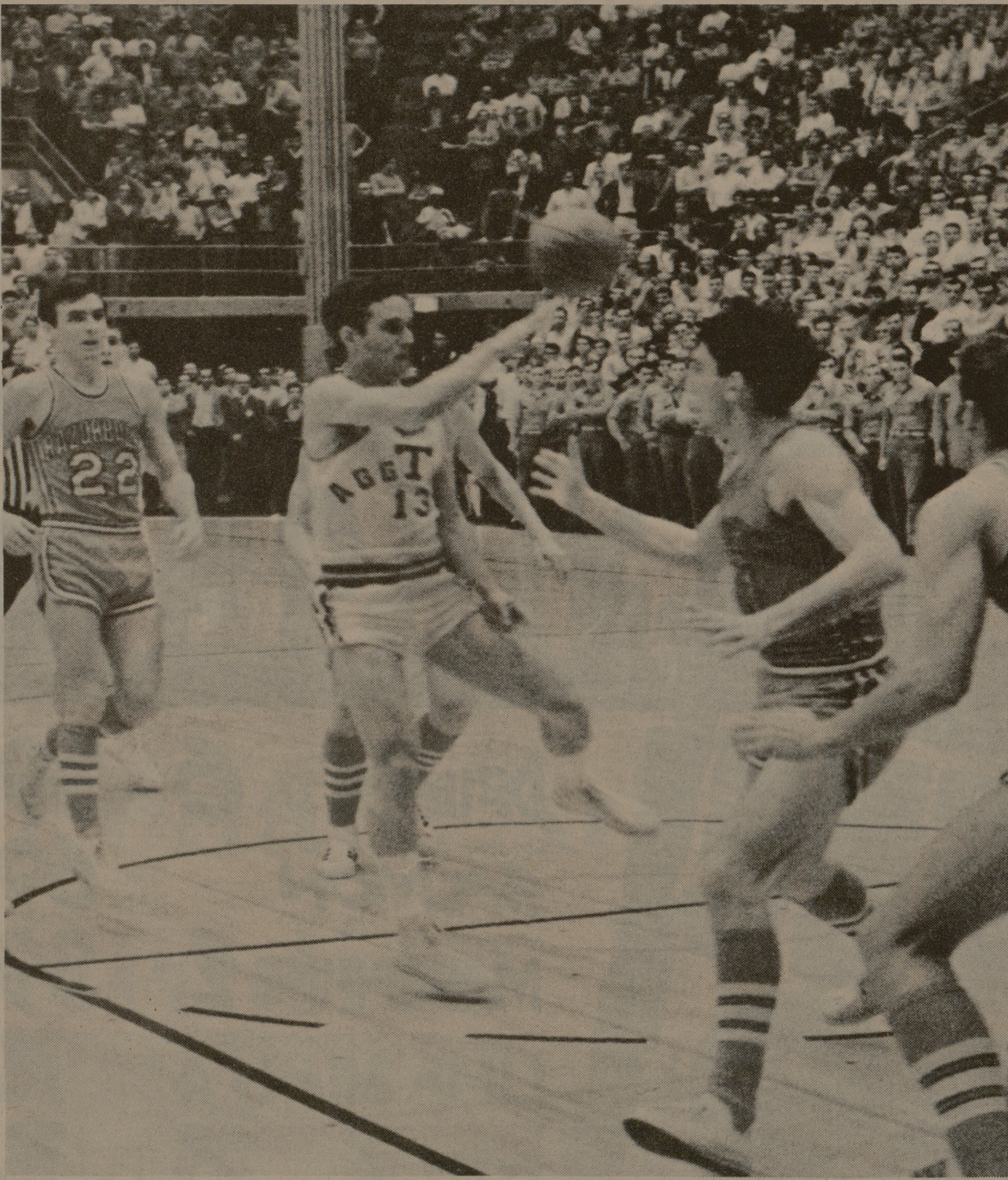


Ag Cindermen Host Longhorns Friday

The Texas Aggies open their indoor track season here Friday afternoon with a dual meet against the University of Texas. Field events start at 1:30 p.m. Running events begin at 2:30. Morning will be 5-3-1 in individual events and 5-0 in relay races. Each school can enter up to five performers in field events and up to five in the 100-yard dash. Each will be limited to three in the hurdles races and four in other running events. A&M's Rockie Woods will be a key performer, competing in the 100, 220, high hurdles and running a leg on the 440-yard relay team.
