**Vets Can Not 'Go It Alone,' Symposium Speaker Declares**

The days when either a physician or a veterinarian can "go it alone" and attempt to meet the medical needs of most of his patients are nearly gone, a medical doctor told veterinarians here Monday.

"As single individuals they have limited skills, limited resources and limited capacity to deal with the widely varied problems of their patients," noted Dr. Vincent E. Price.

Price is special assistant to the director, National Institute of General Medical Sciences, National Institutes of Health, Bethesda, Md. He addressed the Monday session of the Fourth Symposium on Veterinary Medical Education.

"THE ADVANTAGES of a group practice, which permits a group of general practitioners and specialists to provide a broad array of competence and skills to their patients, appear to be gaining greater acceptance among both the veterinary and medical community," Dr. Price observed.

Discussing what he termed a "biological revolution" in the professions, Price said, "One can visualize the day in the not-too-distant future when the physicians and veterinarians in a given community or region will be joined by a group of scientists, working as full and equal colleagues, to provide the community with the full range of scientific knowledge and skills that are now becoming available through biomedical research."

Competing teams were from Amarillo, Austin, Bellaire, Dallas, Galveston, Houston, Killeen, Mesquite and San Antonio.
