## IM Swim Champs Crowned

Squadron two swept both relays to win the Class A swimming title while A-2 and squadron 12 tied for the Class B title and Crocker Hall took Class C honors.

backstroke in 36.1 while Robert Dwellen won the 100 meter freestyle in 1:05.4.  
Paul Sieburn of Squadron 2 won the diving competition.

Law Hall was edged by Crocker Hall in a two way race for the Class C championship. Most of the other competitors had been eliminated in the preliminaries.

In winning the Class A title, Squadron two more than doubled second-place C-1's total points. Charles Brown paced the win with a 31.5 first place finish in the 50 meter butterfly. Brown also did the butterfly in the third leg of the medley relay and brought his team from third at the halfway mark into the lead.

C-2 took third while A-1 won fourth with Byron Davis winning the 100 meter breaststroke. Other first place finishers in Class A were Bruce Baxter of F-1 in the 50 meter backstroke and Bob Smith of Squadron 10 in the 100 meter freestyle.

John Plotnick of D-2 won the diving.

A-2 and Squadron 12 split the relay events in Class B to end in their tie. Squadron 12 won the 200 meter freestyle relay while A-2 won the 200 meter medley relay. William Krell won the 50 meter butterfly for Squadron 12 in 36.8.

A-1 finished third as Russell Hawkins won the 100 meter breaststroke and they also won second in the medley relay.

Two individual event championships came from Squadron 11. Wayne Lutz won the 50 meter
