By A&M Students' Survey

Poor Driving Practices Noted

A three-hour spot traffic survey by Texas A&M driver edu-

cation students indicates many Bryan-College Station drivers are failing to communicate with each other, declared Dr. Leslie V. Hawkins.

Thirteen students in 15-minute driving sessions polled 200 "unsafe driving acts," Hawkins said. Failure to use signals when turning and making lane changes was the most prevailing bad habit, he noted.

Hawkins, professor of industrial education, added the unsafe acts point out "a failure of drivers to communicate with other drivers."

"PEOPLE are making mistakes in their driving habits and are getting hurt," he emphasized. "They do not communicate with other drivers in time for the other drivers to adjust to their maneuvers."

Noting the survey was a student assignment, not a scientific study, Hawkins said he was "not condemning anyone," but wanted to call the bad habits to the drivers' attention.

"I want to get my students use to observing the mistakes of other drivers," continued Hawkins, "in order that they will develop defensive driving habits."

HAWKINS said as people systematically observe the mistakes of others, they will become "more aware of their own mistakes."

Drivers were checked for either a violation or poor driving habit.

The students recorded 62 failures to use signals, followed by 34 speeding offenses. Following too closely rated third and turning from a wrong lane was fourth.

Other poor habits observed included failure to stop for red lights, driving in another's blind spot, crossing over median, failure to stop for stop signs and weaving in and out of traffic.

Theft, Vandalism Being Investigated

Campus Security is investigating a theft at the Air Force Ball Saturday night and vandalism in the A&M Library Friday night.

Officer J. D. Gossett said Wednesday a \$700 check and \$30 in cash had been taken at Saturday night's ball in Duncan Dining Hall. He noted that the bank where the account was held has been notified to withhold payment on the check.

Gossett reported also that the number of dorm thefts had decreased this month with the arrest of a student who admitted several of the residence hall thefts. The student's name is being withheld at Campus Security request.

"The money was taken from a cigar box in the kitchen of the dining hall, and so far no fingerprints or other clues have been found," Gossett said.

The library was vandalized Friday night but evidently the person or persons who committed the act didn't take anything of value, Gossett noted.

He added that damage consisted of two broken windows in the faculty study room of the library, a picture damaged in the documents room, and several elevator knobs broken.
