

Astros Start 11 Games At Home

The Houston Astros open an important 11-game home stand on Thursday, June 19, when they take on three of their Western Division foes — San Diego, San Francisco and Atlanta.

A five-game series with the San Diego Padres on June 19-22 will feature the only home doubleheader of the season for Houston. A two-night doubleheader on Friday, June 20, starting at 5:30 p.m., will be "Foley's - General Electric Night" when \$2,300 worth of GE appliances will be given to some lucky fans. Registration blanks for the drawing may be picked up at Foley's Department Stores or at the Astrodome on June 20.

Other games in the San Diego series include night games Thursday, June 19 and Saturday, June 21, and a "Family Day" game on Sunday, June 22 at 2:00 p.m. Willie Mays and Willie McCovey will lead the San Francisco Giants into the Dome for night games Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday, June 23-24-25.

The high flying Atlanta Braves use the home stand with a weekend series on June 27-28-29. Saturday night, June 28, will be "Poster Night" when the Astros will give to each youngster a free, colorful 24" x 36" poster with action color pictures of the Astros.

Consolidated Boy Scouts Contract

Bob Schleider, an A&M Consolidated pitching star, has signed a bonus baseball contract with the Montreal Expos and left Tuesday bound for Bradenton, Fla., where he will play in a rookie league.

Schleider once pitched a perfect game, striking out all 21 batters faced earlier this year. He was chosen by Montreal Thursday in the baseball draft and was signed Sunday morning by Red Wolf, a former major league pitcher, now a scout for the Expos.

SF Grants A&M Equipment Money

Grants totalling \$30,600 have been awarded Texas A&M University by the National Science Foundation for equipment to improve undergraduate instruction, President Earl Rudder announced. Four separate awards to be effective July 1. Equipment will be acquired by the Entomology, Chemistry, Industrial Education and Physics Departments within two years. The awards stipulate that equipment must definitely enhance innovation in undergraduate instruction.

a Southwest Conference school last week in the Oxcart Relays Saturday night in Karnes City with a blistering 39.9. The other member of the congregation was weightman Ronnie Lightfoot, who garnered a third place in the discus.

Mills also won the 440-yard dash in 46.4, placed second in

the 220-yard dash with a 21.2, and finished second in the high jump. Woods won the 100-yard dash in 9.5 and Abbott won the high hurdles in 14.1.
