

Purdue Professor Bassman **To Join A&M Economics**

Dr. Robert L. Basmann of Purdue University will join the faculty of Texas A&M's Department of Economics in September, announced Dr. M. L. Greenhut, economics head.

Basmann becomes the second internationally recognized economist to affiliate with the College of Liberal Arts' department. Dr. Oskar Morgenstern, Princeton mathematical economist, will serve as adjunct distinguished professor.
