

Marine Extension Develops

Texas A&M is developing a long-range program to station marine extension specialists along the Gulf Coast, just as it now supports agricultural agents throughout the state.

The project, which emphasizes applied research, demonstration and education, is supported by

Texas A&M's Sea Grant Program and is part of the university's Texas Agricultural Extension Service.

Last year Texas A&M was one of six U. S. universities selected by the National Science Foundation for major institutional support to develop the nation's ma-

rine resources. Texas A&M this month received a \$750,000 NSF grant for second-year operations.

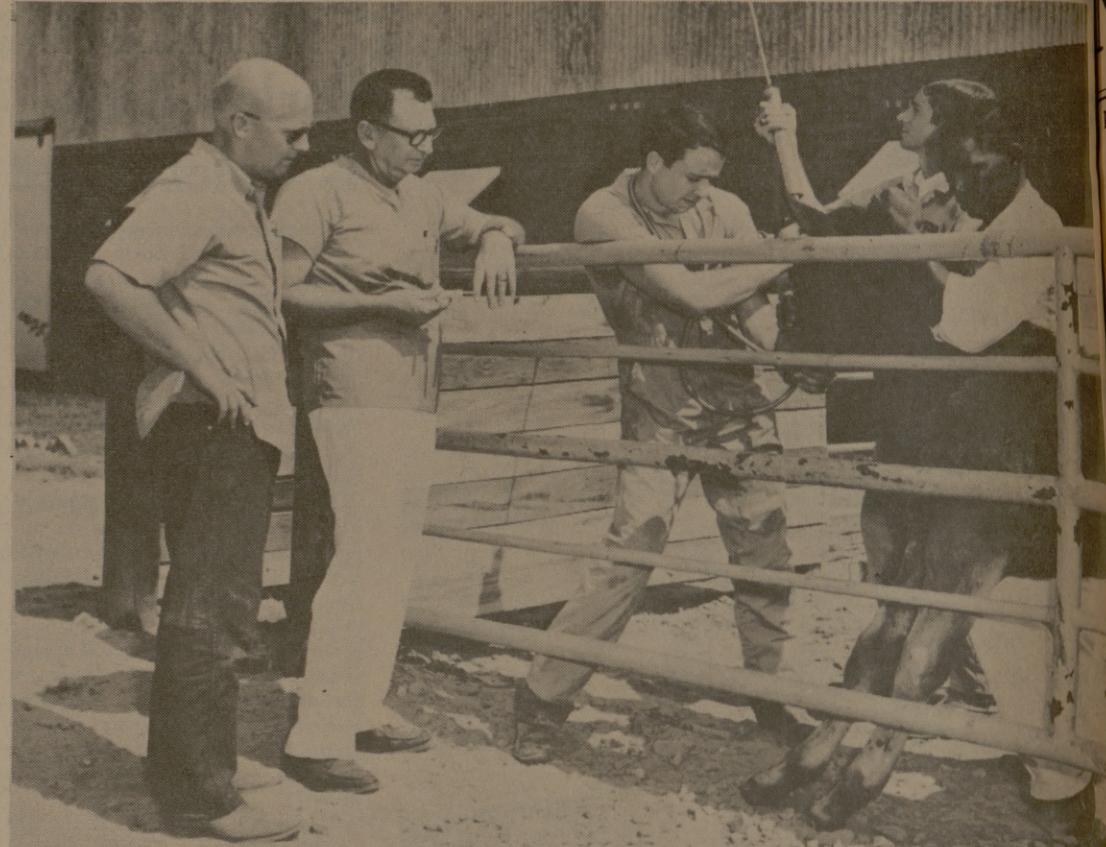
"Five years from now," explained Wallace G. Klussmann, "we hope the commercial fisherman and other marine resources users will think to call the marine extension agent for advice, just

as his counterparts in agriculture call their county agent today."

Klussmann, TAES specialist who coordinates the university's Sea Grant Advisory Program, said current efforts focus on identifying problems and pinpointing users of newly developed techniques.

One such problem involves finding profitable uses for coastal marsh land—solutions other than simply filling them in for housing developments.

A promising approach is conversion of such marshes into shrimp culturing ponds, Klussmann noted. He said the university is exploring the concept with experimental ponds in Brazoria County, south of Houston, and is receiving valuable assistance from private industry and government on both the local and national level.

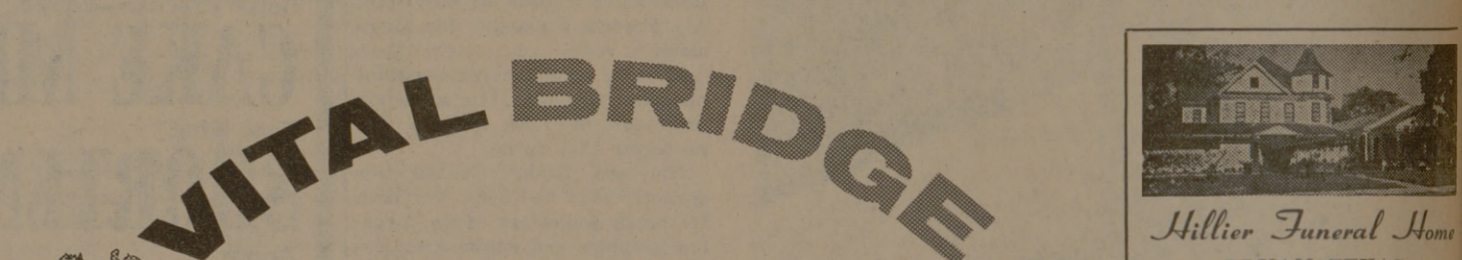
