Merrifield Named Forest Dept. Head

Dr. Robert G. Merrifield is the head of the new Department of Forest Science.

The announcement was made by Dr. H. O. Kunkel, dean of the A&M College of Agriculture, after budgetary plans for establishing the new department were approved during a meeting of the A&M System Board of Directors here Wednesday.

Forest Science Department operations will start at the beginning of the fall semester and will offer bachelor and master degrees in addition to the existing PhD program, Kunkel said. The degree plans were approved last month by the Texas Coordinating Board for Colleges and Universi-

The dean said the new department is in the School of Natural Biosciences along with the Departments of Range Science, Wildlife Science and Recreation

Merrifield came to A&M in 1967 from the Louisiana State University Agricultural Experiment Station, where his research focused on forest stand establishment in old fields and stand regeneration in existing forests. His primary research interests deal with intensive culture of hardwoods and growth and yield of pine plantations.
