

# Manning Impresses Vaught

You'll never get Johnny Vaught compare quarterbacks, but he say that Archie Manning's record-smashing evening Saturday was "the greatest performance by a quarterback I've ever seen."

And the Mississippi coach has some beaux. Eagle Day, Ryan Griffing, Jake Gibbs . . . reached stardom under Vaught. But none ever matched the show put on by Manning as the Miss dropped a 33-32 heart-breaker to Alabama.

Twenty-four national, Southeastern Conference, Mississippi and Alabama offensive records fell as Manning completed 33 of 52 passes for 436 yards and two touchdowns and carried 15 times for 104 yards and Ole Miss' other three scores.

For his 540-yard performance, Manning, a 6-foot-3, 198 pound junior from Drew, Miss., was named college football's Back of the Week by The Associated Press Tuesday.

Even though Alabama won—with Scott Hunter completing 22 of 29 for 300 yards—Coach Bear

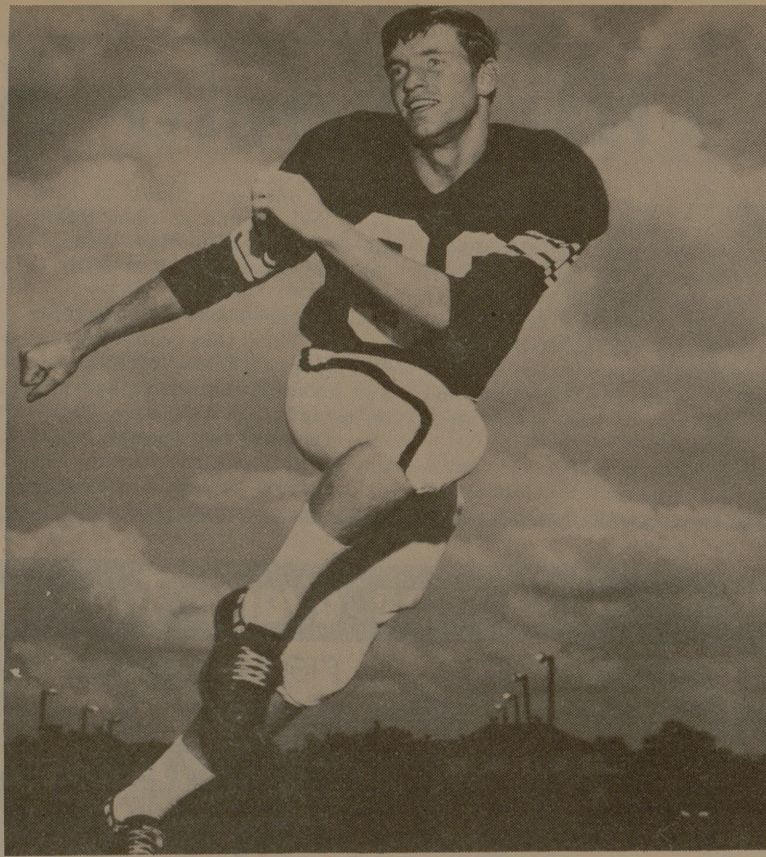
Bryant was stunned by Manning's show.

"To think that offensive records could be set against us," said the Bear, noted for his stingy defensive units, "I wonder what folks like Lee Roy Jordan (now a pro linebacker) would say about that."

"The honor makes me feel real good," Manning said, "but I'd feel better if we'd won the game. I thought Hunter did a tremendous job and deserves some honor, too."

Manning was lavish with praise for all concerned.

"We're real fortunate to have very fine receivers," he said. "And our offensive linemen have been great all year. Saturday night was their best job."

## Player of the Week

Dave Elmendorf won the Batt's Player-Of-The-Week title after a close battle with kicker Mike Bellar as each performed outstandingly against Army Saturday.

Elmendorf, a junior defensive halfback from Houston Westbury, was instrumental in the Aggies' 20-13 victory because he twice tackled Army's fullback Lynn Moore just before he scored on long runs. The first was a 63-yard burst from scrimmage and it looked like Moore would score until Elmendorf bounced him out of bounds on the Aggie 11. The second, in the fourth quarter, Moore broke down the left sideline on route to an 80-yard kickoff return before Elmendorf caught him at the 10.

Elmendorf was also credited with an interception in the fourth quarter which broke Army's back as they tried desperately to even the score before time ran out. In high school Elmendorf was an All-American griddler on both offense and defense and is a distinguished student at A&M and an All-SWC baseball player.

## Scoring Sparse In 'Mural Tilts

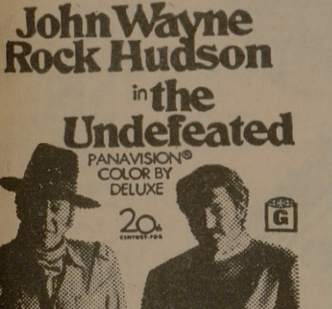
