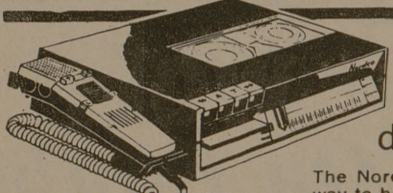

Autocross Set By Car Club

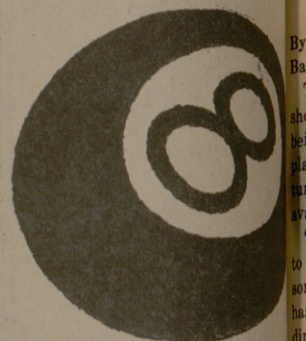

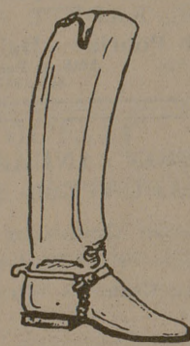

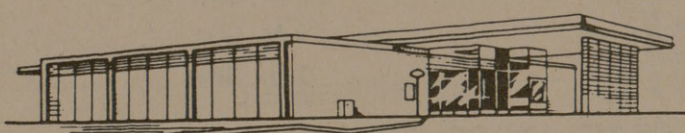
