Dallas Firm Introduces Student Discount Card 'Incredible Card' Available

A student can pay for his card by cash or by selling cards to his friends at a commission of \$5 per card sold.

A discount shopping service which allows the student to shop at a discount at various local stores participating in the program.

The student gets his packet, it includes an auto quote form on which he lists the make, model and all options which he is interested in.

The card, a product of Computer Services Corporation of Dallas, is a by-product of a company formed by Harris Ballow which sold life insurance to college seniors.

Baldrige Listed Missing in Action

Air Force 1st Lt. John R. (Butch) Baldrige, First Wing commander in the 1968 Corps of Cadets, has been listed missing in action in Vietnam.

After survival school, he trained in the O2A at Elgin AFB, Fla. Baldrige departed for Southeast Asia Oct. 10 with a week of jungle training in the Philippines scheduled enroute.
