in Room 317 of the Animal Industries Building. Dr. James Smith of the A&M Plant Sciences Department said


Eigsti's research interests for the past 20 years have centered on problems dealing with polyploidy and with triploid watermelons in particular.

A triploid melon is one which has three sets of chromosomes instead of the usual two.

Smith said Eigsti received his doctorate in botany from the University of Illinois and did post-doctoral work with the Department of Genetics of the Carnegie Institution of Washington. He has been a Fulbright Lecturer to Pakistan, a UNESCO Lecturer to India and has held two visiting research appointments in Japan.

At 24 degrees north latitude and 89.5 degrees west longitude during the March 7 event, the eclipse will begin at 10.25 and end at 1:25 p.m.




"Huey Long and His Politics" is the topic for a Feb. 19 University Lecture at Texas A&M.




