**Civic Auditorium to Offer  
'Fiddler on Roof' Sunday**

"Fiddler on the Roof," highly-successful Broadway play that has triumphed around the world, goes on Bryan and College Station boards Sunday in a two-performance stand as a TAMU Special Attraction.

"Fiddler" takes its title from a passage in the musical. "Without our traditions, our lives would be as — as a fiddler on the roof!" the line goes.

Tevye, the central figure, is a winning, loveable character. He is a dairyman in a Russian village, Anatevka, in the period of 1905. His wife Golde is a bitter-sweet character, hard on the surface and tender underneath.

They have five daughters, three of marriageable age. Tevye and Golde's offspring present problems to their parents, just as

children do today, especially when it comes to matrimony. The tale of these people is touching, funny and told in story, melody and dance.

Sings from the Harold Prince production have zoomed to popularity in unique numbers, offering probably more than any other recent musical.

In this category are composer Jerry Bock's and lyricist Sheldon Harnick's "Matchmaker, Matchmaker," "If I Were a Rich Man," "Sunrise, Sunrise," "Miracle of Miracles" and "Far From The Home I Love." They have been recorded in over a dozen different languages and by most major recording stars.

The Harold Prince touring company that will appear at Bryan Civic Auditorium Sunday in 2:30 p.m. matinee and 8:30 p.m. performances stars burly Bob Carroll in the role of Tevye.

As parents do today, Tevye struggles to make what little money he can against great odds, makes matches for three of his daughters without a decent dowry among them and contends with the generation gap.

Tevye has faith in a very personal God that he talks to frequently. His unique philosophy of life not only solves most of his

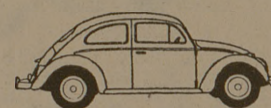
problems but makes him a symbol of eternal man triumphant even in defeat.

But even the traditions and faith which "Fiddler's" characters hold to are not enough at times. Tevye's life is shattered when he learns his daughters are straying away from the tradition of Pappa-made marriage matches.

Directed by Jerome Robbins, the large cast features Laura Stuart as Golde; Joel Wolfe as Lazar Wolf, the Butcher; Charlotte Jones as Yente, the Matchmaker, and Mary Ann Chinn, Doreen Dunn and Alexandra Stoddart as the three daughters.

The boys they select as husbands are Stacy McAdams, Sidney Ben-Zali and Lewis Jacobson. The Innkeeper is played by Leon Spelman; Sanford Seeger is the Rabbi and Mendel, his son, is portrayed by Sidney Bruce. George Emch is the gruff but sympathetic Constable and Joel Frederick as Avram, the Book-seller, add greatly to the plot of the award-winning musical.

Tickets to the TAMU special attraction are available only at the Student Program Office in the MSC. Matinee prices begin at \$3 and evening performance tickets start at \$3.50.
