# Teer Named Head Of Wildlife Science

gained national prominence as project leader for the Caesar Kleberg Chair of Wildlife Science, is the new head of the Wildlife Science Department.

Dr. H. O. Kunkel, dean of the College of Agriculture, said the appointment was effective this week. Teer, previously an associate professor at A&M, will receive a full professorship Sept. 1 through previous action by the Board of Directors.


