The subjects they chose are indeed beautiful. There are the feathery ferns. There are the protected wildflowers, which may be picked sparingly, if at all-Dutchman's-breeches, yellow and pink ladyslippers, painted and white trillium, birdfoot violet, yellow wood, sorrel, adder'stongue and others.

One fabric, a study of trees, depicts the chestnut, which is being harmed by fungus blight; the elm, which is going fast due to beetle destruction; the coast redwoods and giant sequoias, which are in great danger; and the bristlecone pine.

The delightful bird fabrics include mourning doves, ducks, house wrens, veeries and sparrows. The snowy egret is a regal motif among lotus blossoms. Some are Audubon birds; one hummingbird is from a Don Eckelberry
