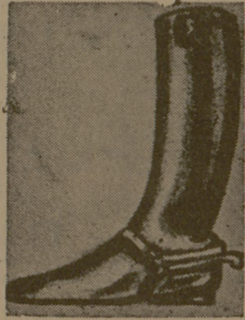

Texas A&M cited 16 faculty-staff members for distinguished service at its annual Faculty Recognition and Awards Program Thursday.

The Association of Former Students presented \$1,000 awards and Commemorative watches to 12 members of the university's faculty and staff. The Standard Oil (Indiana) Foundation made three similar \$1,000 presentations.

Former Students awards for teaching went to Dr. Zerle L. Carpenter, associate professor of animal science; Dr. John W. Huff, associate professor, veterinary

microbiology; Prof. Price Hobbard, head of the Agricultural Engineering Department.
