

Edgar receives service award

Dr. J. W. Edgar, 47-year Texas education veteran in his 20th year as state commissioner of education, was awarded last week the "Golden Deeds for Education" award.

The award cited distinguished service in promoting progress of education in Texas.

Dr. Edgar, 65, was accorded the honor by state school administrators, county superintendents, and instructional supervisors associations in conference at Texas A&M.

"Dr. Edgar has served longer than any other man as chief administrator of education in Texas," commented Dr. W. W. Jackson of San Antonio. He presented the award at the final assembly of the three-day conference.

Jackson, former chairman of the board that appoints the commissioner, said Dr. Edgar gives "exceptional talent, insight and unusual sensitivity to the local schools' desire for autonomy" to the position.

"He has the rare ability of having the complete confidence of his staff, people at the state and local levels and the 21 State

Board of Education members," Jackson declared.

The "Golden Deeds" award plaque was presented following an annual report on the status of Texas education to conference participants by Dr. Edgar and L. P. Sturgeon, Texas State Teachers Association executive secretary-treasurer.

Sturgeon is one of six recipients of the award initiated in 1964. The first went to Senator A. M. Alken of Paris. Other recipients are former Texas A&M education heads who coordinated the conference in its 45 years at the university.

Dr. Edgar taught and served administratively in Burnet County, Heidenheimer, Victoria, Miranda City, Orange and Austin schools before appointment as state commissioner in 1950. He was school superintendent in Miranda City, Orange and Austin.

He received the B.A. degree at Howard Payne, M.A. and doctor of education at the University of Texas, doctor of letters at Austin College in 1958 and doctor of literature at Southwestern University in 1967.
