

Former vet dean to speak

Dr. Willis William Armistead, former dean of veterinary medicine at Texas A&M, will be commencement speaker for the institution's veterinary medicine graduation ceremonies Aug. 7.

The exercises will be conducted at 8 p.m. in Bryan Civic Auditorium.

Dr. Armistead is now dean of veterinary medicine at Michigan State University. He has held that position since leaving Texas A&M in 1957.

Born in Detroit but reared in Houston, Armistead earned a Doctor of Veterinary Medicine degree at Texas A&M in 1938. Following a two-year private practice in Dallas, he joined the Texas A&M veterinary medicine faculty and rose through the academic ranks. He was named dean in 1953.

In addition to his D.V.M., Dr. Armistead holds a master's degree from Ohio State University and Ph.D. from the University of

Minnesota.

He is a past president of both the American Veterinary Medical Association and the Association of American Veterinary Medical Colleges and is a member of numerous scholarly and professional societies.

Dr. Armistead has served in top editorial positions for key professional publications, including "The North American Veterinarian" and "Journal of the American Animal Hospital Assn.

Department to get \$40,500 grant

The Department of Nuclear Engineering has received notification of a \$40,500 grant from the U. S. Department of Health, Education and Welfare for its radiological health specialist training project for 1970-71, according to Dr. R. G. Cochran, head.

Dr. Richard D. Neff, associate professor and radiological safety officer, is director of the activity. The funds will provide trainee positions for ten graduate students, Neff said.

Neff came here in 1966 from Michigan State University.

Ph.D. in forestry offered

A cooperative Ph.D. program in forestry will be jointly offered by Texas A&M University and Stephen F. Austin State University, beginning Sept. 1.

Announcement of the agreement was made by Dr. J. N. Gerber, dean of the SFA Graduate School, and Dr. George W. Kunze, dean of Texas A&M's Graduate College.

The cooperative doctoral program was originally proposed by the Coordinating Board, Texas College and University System, to "make use of the unusual

strengths of each institution."

Students earning the Ph.D. in forestry will receive their degrees from Texas A&M but they may take as much as half of their formalized course work at the Nacogdoches institution, the deans explained.

They said a joint six-member graduate advisory council will be established for coordination and administration of this and other cooperative graduate programs. The overall program will include cross appointment of professors to the other institution's gradu-

ate faculty.

Both Stephen F. Austin and Texas A&M have a long history in forestry education. SFA's School of Forestry has programs leading to Bachelor of Science and Master of Science degrees while Texas A&M has traditionally offered the Ph.D. degree in forestry.

Texas A&M recently received Coordinating Board approval to offer Bachelor of Science and Master of Science degrees in conjunction with the formation of a Department of Forest Science.

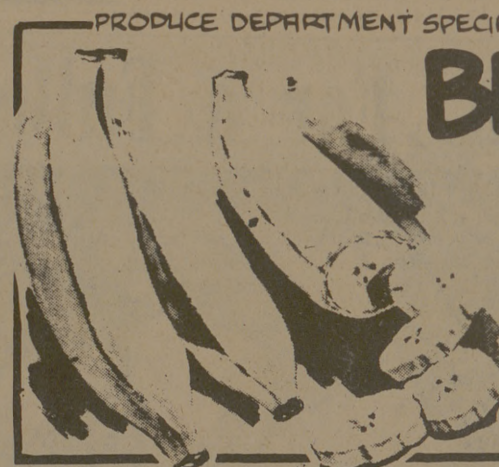

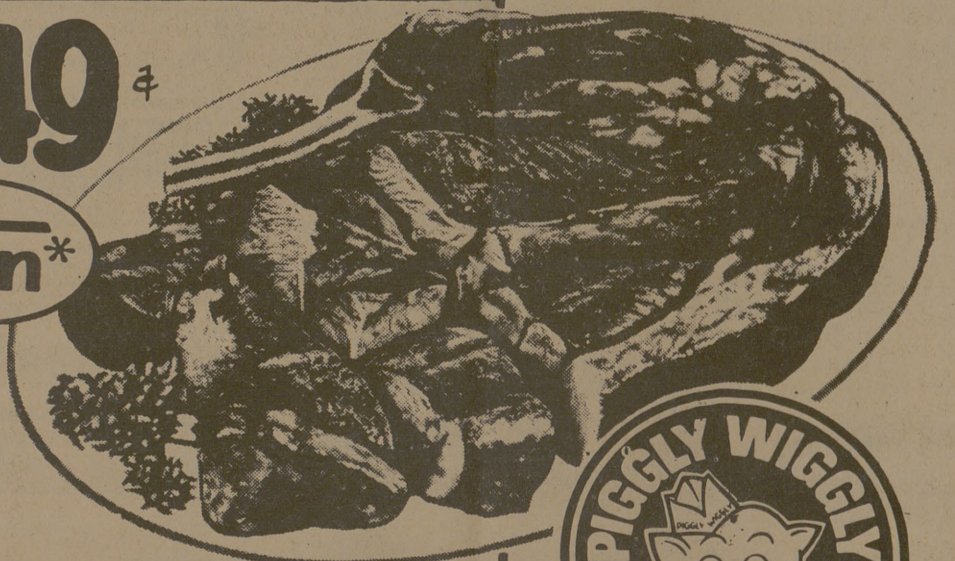
