Colleges and universities from throughout the state have been invited to participate in Sept. 14-15 hearings of the Texas House of Representatives' Interim Study Committee on Oceanography at College Station.

Rep. Ray Lemmon of Houston committee chairman, said the session is designed to give approximately 25 institutions of higher learning an opportunity to explain the scope of their oceanographic and marine-related programs.

Invitations were extended on the basis of known programs at various colleges and universities, primarily public institutions, the Houston lawmaker explained. He noted, however, that all institu tions — public or private — are welcome to attend. All sessions will be open to the public, he added.
