

The new look schedules are partly the result of the extension of the college season to a maximum of 11 games this year and partly the result of a trend toward scheduling the most attractive opposition possible rather

than "loading up" on weaker area teams.

In recent seasons, such nationally respected teams as Purdue, Oklahoma and Southern California began appearing on some SWC team's non-conference schedules for the first time. In the 1960's the SWC managed only a 131-125-11 advantage over stronger intersectional foes. This percentage of 51.1 compares to a mark of 68.8 record during the
