## Cheavens, noted journalist, dies at conference here

Dave Cheavens, 63, noted newsman and journalism educator, died Tuesday afternoon in a Bryan hospital after suffering a heart attack in the Memorial Student Center late Sunday.

Cheavens came to Texas A&M University to attend a meeting of a committee to draft a new constitution for the Southwest Journalism Congress. He had been plagued by heart problems for several years and collapsed in the MSC about 6 p.m.

At the time of his death, he was chairman of the Department of Journalism of Baylor University, Waco.

Until two or three years ago he also was director for public relations of the university but had surrendered that post because of health. Cheavens had worked many places in the world as a newsman. Before joining his old love, Baylor University, in 1961, he had been an Associated Press newsman for 26 years. At the time he went with Baylor, he was chief correspondent for The Associated Press at the Texas capital of Austin, where he first went in 1938. Earlier, he was Texas state editor of The Associated Press stationed in Dallas.
