Arkansas' Bill Burnett wins Kern Tips award

Bill Burnett, record-setting tailback from the University of Arkansas, was named winner of the Third Annual Kern Tips Memorial Award in Dallas Wednesday.

The trophy, named for the late Southwest Conference radio broadcaster Kern Tips, was presented to Burnett by James H. Galloway, Vice President and member of the Board of Directors of Humble Oil & Refining Company.

It is given each year to the outstanding senior football player in the Southwest Conference, who, in addition to his ability on the field, is academically ranked, displays good sportsmanship and is of high moral character.

Despite missing a large portion of the season with a shoulder separation, Burnett established an impressive record of rushing and scoring honors. He holds the Arkansas career record for scoring and rushing, was Southwest Conference scoring leader in both 1968 and 1969, and missed being conference scoring leader this year by one touchdown.

He is almost assured of being the NCAA career leader in points scored per game with an average of 11.48 for 25 games. Burnett

was on the All-SWC team in 1968 and 1969. Last year he was named to the SWC All-Academic team as well as the All-American Academic team.

An education major, Burnett is the son of Mr. and Mrs. Clell Burnett of Bentonville, Arkansas. His accumulative grade point average at Arkansas is 3.36 on a 4.0 system. Last semester he

posted an impressive 3.57. He is vice president of the Razorback chapter of the Fellowship of Christian Athletes and active in various student activities.

Chris Gilbert, University of Texas back, was the winner of the First Annual Kern Tips award in 1968. Last year's winner was Buster Adams, linebacker from Texas A&M.

SWC officials consider Cougars

The Southwest Conference will consider extending an invitation to the University of Houston to become its ninth member when faculty representatives and athletic department officials meet in Dallas this week.

The winter meetings of SWC coaches and officials will be held today, Friday and Saturday, at the Baker Hotel.

Athletic directors and head coaches are meeting today from 8 a.m. until 6 p.m. Athletic directors, coaches and business managers meet from 8:30 a.m. until noon Friday. Faculty representatives begin their sessions at 1 p.m. Friday and continue again at 9 a.m. Saturday.

The University of Texas at Austin will propose that the University of Houston be invited to join the conference. If this proposal is accepted, Texas will recommend that a committee of SWC officials meet with a similar committee representing the University of Houston to formulate admission plans.

Among the other topics to come under consideration by the faculty representatives:

Adoption of a policy that would make it possible for athletic directors of the member institutions to attend conference meetings in an advisory capacity. Should this policy be adopted each school would still be limited to one vote, to be cast by the faculty representatives;

Football ticket prices for the 1971 season. This season conference game ticket prices were \$6 for reserved seats, \$3 for end zone seats, half price for students of the visiting school, and \$1 for high school students and service personnel;

Consideration and general review of coaches' agreements on recruiting;

The possibility of increasing the maximum limit on freshman basketball games from 12 to 16, with a maximum of six games away from home;

Permitting summer school work to be counted toward meeting academic requirements for athletic eligibility. Currently, only work posted during regular school sessions counts toward eligibility;

Policy regarding participation of freshmen on both varsity and freshman squads. The SWC now permits freshmen to participate in varsity athletics in all sports except football and basketball, with the stipulation that once a freshman engages in a sport on the varsity level he cannot later in the season play on the freshman level. The suggestion is that freshmen be allowed to participate on both levels, so long as they do not participate in more contests than SWC rules permit.
