Railroad strike leader issues halt order to avoid heavy fine

WASHINGTON OF - Nationwide railroad strike leader C. L. Dennis said Thursday night he had ordered his men back to work after a federal judge threatened fines of \$200,000 a day against the union.

Dennis, at a news conference at the Labor Department shortly after U. S. District Judge John H. Pratt found the union in contempt of court, said his back-to-work order should end the crippling strike.

However, Dennis earlier had released copies of telegrams from union members insisting on continuing the strike.

Dennis said the Labor Department had assured him of speedy
