A high level of poeticides has been discovered by Texas A&M University oceanographers in a fish captured more than 100 miles out in the Gulf of Mexico.

Dr. Thomas J. Bright, chief scientist for the cruise during which the fish was caught, said the significance of the discovery is two-fold: that posticides have

netrated so far offshore and high level of concentration.

The fish, a barracuda measur-ing three and one-half feet in

length, was caught during some general investigations at the Flower Garden Banks 120 miles south-southeast of Galveston.
