Elmendorf, who posted the highest
scholastic average among the
honorees, and linebacker Steve
Luebbehusen have been named to
the defensive unit of the 1970 All-
Southwest Conference All-Academic
team.

Elmendorf, an economics ma-
jor, posted a 3.84 with another
defensive back, Bobby Field of
Arkansas second with a 3.41.

He was named Academic All-
America last year as a junior and
is almost certain to be on the

first team again this fall.

Master plan made by Architecture for Port Aransas

Several students in the College of Architecture and Environmental Design have prepared a master plan for the City of Port Aransas, which is rebuilding in the wake of last summer's Hurricane Celia.

Public presentation of the students' plans was completed this week at the Port Aransas Town Hall.

The project was undertaken by a section of students in the College of Architecture and Environmental Design's fourth-year design class.

Assistant Professor Anthony Caporina coordinated activities.

Funds for the study were provided by the George Hawn Foundation and the college.

The students became interested in preparing the master plan after conversations with Corpus Christi architects.

Initial planning by the students was well received by Port Aransas officials and the Coastal Bend Regional Planning Commission.

"Although manipulating the physical environment, emphasis centered on human development," Caporina explained, "and recreation provided the means for achieving these goals."

He said one of the more challenging facets of the project was the "sensitive use of the area's delicate ecosystem to provide the resources needed for recreation."

"As it turned out," the professor concluded, "nature also provided the only protection from hurricanes with its tall sand dunes which run along the gulf."

Students chosen for tournament

John Moffitt of Midland, David Line of Monahans, Joe Turner of Pasadena and William M. Kostura of Dallas will represent A&M in chess at the Region XII American College Unions intercollegiate games tournament.

The four students won an A&M chess championship tourney to gain berths in the competition at Baton Rouge Feb. 18-20.

Memorial Student Center Chess Committee chairman Bill Lockwood of Fort Worth said the committee will pay the players' expenses to compete in the tournament.
