## Traffic noise part of Institute study

A&M's Texas Transportation Institute is initiating a research program to determine means for reducing highway traffic noise.

The study is sponsored by the Texas Highway Department and the Federal Highway Administration.

Dr. Donald L. Woods, TTI associate research engineer who heads the study, said the project will include evaluation and recommendation of threshold noise levels for various land use activities.

Based on results of the study, TTI researchers will recommend a procedure for evaluating traffic

noise potential for proposed highways and suggest traffic noise reduction techniques for use on existing traffic facilities.

The TTI study will also establish the degree of traffic noise level near urban highways in Texas, Woods noted.

Another facet of the study involves evaluation and recommendation of equipment for traffic noise measurement.

## Judge throws out Kent State Grand Jury report

CLEVELAND, Ohio (AP) — A federal judge today threw out a grand jury report critical of the Kent State University administration but let stand 25 indictments the jury returned as a result of violence on the campus last May.

U.S. District Court Judge William K. Thomas ordered the report of the special Portage County grand jury to be "physically expunged and destroyed" within 10 days.

His 50-page memorandum ruled against all of the 18-page grand jury report except for the indictments.

The jury investigation was ordered by former Gov. James A. Rhodes after 13 students were shot, four of them fatally, during a confrontation with National Guardsmen on the campus last May 4.

The jury's report was critical of the Kent State administration and stated that the National Guardsmen on the campus were not liable to criminal prosecution.

## Sharpstown will not reopen; FDIC and state will liquidate

DALLAS (AP) — The Federal Deposit Insurance Corp. announced Wednesday evening it had accepted receivership of Sharpstown State Bank, a defendant in the stock manipulation suit the federal Securities and Exchange Commission has filed.

"This bank will not reopen," Quinton Thompson, FDIC regional director, said in reply to a question after he read a statement in front of the closed bank.

Directors of the bank voted Monday night to turn the bank over to the state for liquidation.

The Sharpstown State Bank, one of the largest state banks in Texas, reported deposits of \$80 million on Jan. 6, but a run by

depositors brought withdrawal of some \$15 million after the SEC filed the civil action suit in Dallas Jan. 18 against Frank W. Sharp, the bank and a number of other companies Sharp controlled.

Thompson's statement said: "The corporation (FDIC) board of directors announced today (Wednesday) that Texas Commissioner of Banking Robert E. Stewart had tendered and it had accepted receivership of the Sharpstown State Bank, Houston, Tex.

"Accordingly, it is proceeding as rapidly as possible to pay off the depositors up to the insured limit within the next few days.

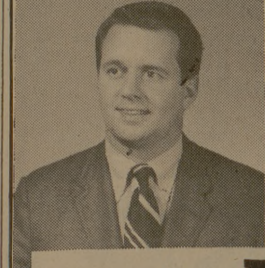

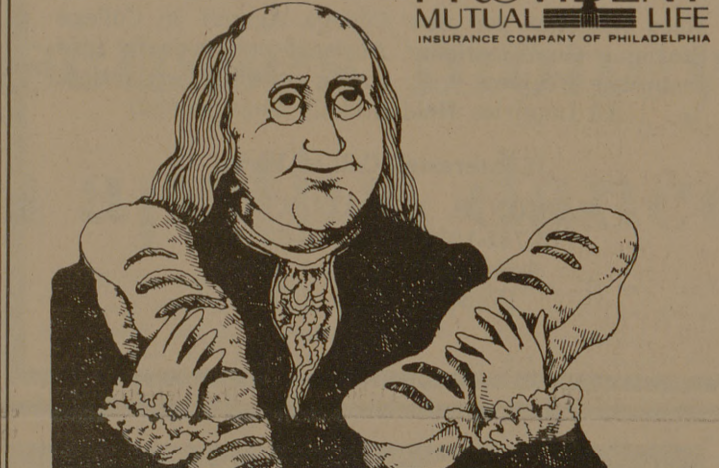
