

Make your own beauty tattoos

Bored with the usual jewelry?
Tired of the same old rings, neck-

laces and earrings? Try a tattoo anywhere you please for almost nothing.

Tattoo a new moon on your neck or a string of tiny hearts around your wrist. And when you are tired of it, just wash it away. They are easily made with tape and food coloring.

First, get either masking or adhesive tape, an inch and a half or two inches wide. Fold the tape with the sticky side inward. Draw half the design you want so that you will have a completed one when the tape is opened. Next, cut out the design and open the tape.

Press the cut out square of tape firmly against your skin where you want the tattoo. Keep it firm so that the food coloring will not seep in around the edges. Outline the tattoo with a fountain pen filled with food coloring.

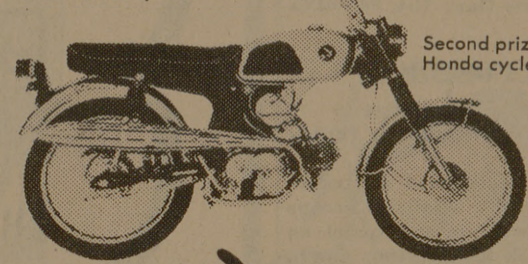

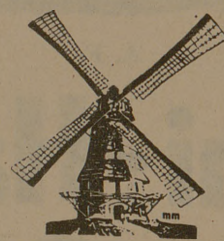
