Max Bird has a tough job: stop the Cincinnati quarterback

Dumb football players are out of style. If you don't believe it, just speak to Aggie defensive end Max Bird.
Bird, 6-1, 218, junior letterman from Amarillo, is a Pre-Med major with a 2.9 grade point average.
His responsibility at defensive end is to contain the quarterback on the option play that is so well used in this league.
"I'll get my sternest test this week against Cincinnati," Bird

stated. "Their quarterback (Albert Johnson) led the nation in rushing for quarterbacks using the option play last year. My job this week will be to make sure he never gets outside me."
His position got a little more complicated this year with the change in the A&M defensive alignment.
"Last year I played in a down position all the time in our five man front," he said. "This year we rotate with the tackles. If we rotate right, I am in the down

position and if the quarterback drops back to pass I must rush. If we rotate left, I am in an up position and have to cover a pass receiver in the flat. Mostly, my job is to contain the quarterback."
After losing the last two games one wonders how the team's attitude is holding up.
"We're still a good football team," Bird pointed out. "It really doesn't matter about non-conference games. Sure, we would like to go 11-0 but the important thing is conference play. As a matter

of fact, a few of us were talking about a Bowl game a couple of days ago."
There is speculation that the defense is getting disheartened with the lack of scoring by the offense.
"That is not true," Bird said. "We're not upset with the offense. They may have some problems scoring but both quarterbacks have been or still are injured. They'll be ready by conference and so will the rest of the offense and so will the rest of the of-

fense, just wait and see."
After playing three number one teams in two years, one wonders how Nebraska compares to the Texas and Ohio State teams of 1970.
"Nebraska has great talent but compared to Ohio State and Texas I think they are the weakest of the three," Bird commented. "The defense is better than the offense. Their big plays are the ones that beat you. I feel we could have beaten them except for the big plays they scored on us, like

the long interception, the kick return, the long pass and the long run. Without Johnny Rodgers Nebraska would be just another good football team. He wins the game for them."
With Cincinnati's great running attack looming for Saturday night, Max knows what it will take to win.
"I will have to keep the quarterback bottled up and when they pass I will have to be in there and put pressure on him," Bird said.
