incorporates 1,800 new entries, with 2,522 in the Bengali section and 2,250 in the English section. Printed by the A&M Press, it uses special type required for the Eastern language, acquired by Dabbs for the first printing through a Department of Health, Education and Welfare (HEW)

A special university grant made third edition printing possible. Income from dictionary sales paid for help of Bengali editorial assistants. In writing several years, the publication is by Dr. Jack D. Gray.
