



Buster Callaway

With all the discussion about the generation gap and the teenage rebellion, Texas A&M's 19-year old left tackle Buster Callaway could not be considered a problem child. All he does for kicks is knock down defensive linemen and open gaping holes for Aggie running backs.

Callaway, a 6-4, 250-pound junior from Ennis, leads the offensive line in consistency and hel-

met stars, grading high in each football game and receiving two stars. These stars were won the past two weeks for 20 and 23 knockdowns against Baylor and Arkansas respectively.

"It's hard for an offensive lineman to get helmet stars," he said. "All we really need is a pat on the back from our ball carriers telling us we did a good job to get enough glory. I guess I'm lucky to have gotten two stars."

It hasn't been luck, since 12

knockdowns is considered a great job. Buster was only one short of doubling that amount against the Razorbacks.

Early in the season, the offensive line was the brunt of much criticism from sports writers and fans alike.

"The problem was that on every play one of us would break down on our assignment," Callaway admitted. "Our line now is finally working together, opening holes for the runner and keep-

ing the defensive players off of our quarterback when he's trying to pass."

After playing the range of teams that the Aggies have, the upset of highly touted Arkansas brings up the question of top teams in comparison.

"Arkansas was big, tough or I should say the toughest team we've played all year," he explained. "They were more consistent than Nebraska or LSU. The only reason we didn't do well

against these other teams is because of our dumb mistakes like fumbles, interceptions and missed blocking assignments."

After winning two straight, confidence runs high in the Aggie camp. Many feel the chances of going to the Cotton Bowl are not as much of a myth as some people might expect.

"I think our chances are great for winning the conference," Buster said. "All that needs to happen is for Arkansas to lose an-

other game and we win the rest of ours. TCU needs to lose another one also. I don't think we'll lose another game all season. Even if Arkansas doesn't lose another game, we'll have a good chance of going to a bowl game somewhere because we beat both Texas and Arkansas.

With SMU on this week's agenda, Buster is not about to overlook its potential with such superlatives as Gary Hammond and Alvin Maxson in the backfield
