Federal jury indicts two auto makers

WASHINGTON (AP) - The ers franchised by the automobile nation's two largest auto manufacturers, General Motors and Ford were indicted by a federal grand jury Monday on charges of conspiring to restrict competition in the fleet market, the Justice Department announced.

The two-count indictment was filed together with a companion civil suit in U. S. District Court in Detroit.

General Motors and Ford quickly responded.

Ford said, "accusations in the indictment are not true," and GM said it will seek an immediate trial, confident it will be vindicated and the government's charges shown to have "no basis in fact."

Named as unindicted co-conspirators were the National Automobile Dealers Association, a trade association of new-car deal-




