Contract for \$89,000 given to A&M Experiment Station

A contract for over \$89,000 has been awarded to the Texas Agricultural Experiment Station to study manpower training requirements in Texas agricultural industries, Dr. H. O. Kunkel, dean of the College of Agriculture and acting director of the Experiment Station at Texas A&M University, announced.

The contract, totaling \$89,180, was awarded over a 14-month period by the Division of Occupational Research and Development, Department of Occupational and Technical Education of the Texas Education Agency in Austin.

Kunkel said the purpose of the study is to determine the number and types of occupations in Texas agricultural industries and to project future manpower training and needs for these occupations. He added there were an estimated five million nonfarm jobs being provided by agricultural indus-

tries, in addition to the employment provided by the production sector of agriculture.

Project Director Dr. Conrad Fritsch, an assistant professor with the Department of Agricultural Economics and Rural Sociology, said a well trained work force is needed to handle the present and future requirements of agriculture.

"Many employers have only a slight understanding of the training provided by vocational agricultural programs and their potential to meet the needs of the employer," he said. "Likewise, many educators are not familiar with the occupational skills and the level of skills required for job entry."

Fritsch added that, in this study, manpower training needs will be identified with respect to secondary, two-year college and four-year college level requirements.

Co-directors of the experiment station project are Dr. John W. Holcomb and Dr. Earl S. Webb, both professors with the Department of Agricultural Education at A&M.

Counselor named at Maritime College

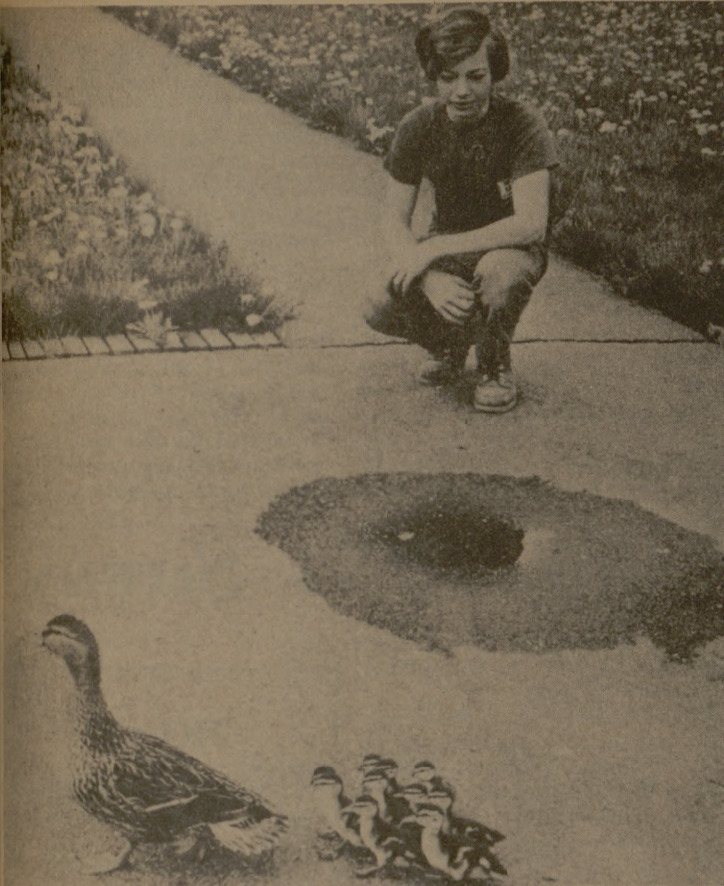
Diane Denman has been appointed academic counselor for A&M's College of Marine Sciences and Maritime Resources, Dean William H. Clayton announced.
