

High school cheerleaders, twirlers attend A&M camp

A&M this week is the site of a different type of summer school. Mrs. Kathryn Fain of Rosenberg opened her annual private camp Sunday for high school cheerleaders, twirlers and drill team members. The camp has attracted 306, including 280 campers and 26 instructors. Only six of the participants are boys.

The campers are from Texas, Florida, Nebraska, Arkansas, Louisiana and Missouri. Instructors include college students, private teachers and former college champions, all considered the best in their areas, Mrs. Fain said.

Students are divided into small groups training throughout the campus. All are housed in Hughes Hall with meals served in Sbis Dining Hall.

Classes continue through Friday morning.

Mrs. Fain said this is the second year the annual camp has been held at TAMU. She said it will continue to be held on campus the last week in June.

Mrs. Fain is an internationally-known twirling and majorette teacher. She has annual camps in Europe and similar programs throughout the South and Southwest every week during the summer months.

He said the cans will be sold

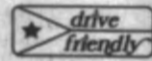
in Houston to raise money for society activities.
