Dr. Dennis A. Berthold joins the faculty as assistant professor in American literature; Dr. Helmut Esau, visiting assistant professor in linguistics, and Mrs. Paul Van Riper, lecturer, for the 1972-73 school year.

Berthold was formerly at the University of Wisconsin, Stevens

Point. He also taught at Savannah State College and the University of Wisconsin, Madison. His B.A. and M.A. degrees are from the University of California, Riverside, his Ph.D., the University of Wisconsin.

The American literature specialist recently completed a bibliography of William Bradford Berthold, his wife and daughter reside at 723 Inwood.

Recently at UCLA, Professor

Esau also taught at the University of Virginia. His degrees are from Eastern Mennonite College, Harrisonburg, Va.; University of Virginia and UCLA. He held a National Defense Fellowship while completing the Ph.D. Esau's interests include English and German linguistics. He has published several articles dealing with nominalization and word order in German.

Mrs. Van Riper has 15 years teaching experience, in Miami Fla., and Ithaca, N. Y., public schools and last year for Blinn College in Bryan. After attending Stephens College, she took the B.A. at the University of Miami. She received the master's at Duke and has 60 hours additional graduate study.

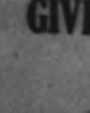
