

Press Tour Invades Aggie Football Camp For New

Over 30 sports writers and sports broadcasters rolled into College Station today to interview new head coach and athletic director Emory Ballard and the 1972 Texas Aggie football team. The press tour is designed to give the states' finest journalists a chance to get interviews, reports and general feelings of the players and coaches of all SWC football teams before the season starts and schedules become conflicting.

The tour began in Lubbock on Monday and traveled to Arkansas Tuesday before coming to Aggieland late Tuesday evening. The tour moved Wednesday afternoon to Houston for interviews with the Rice team, then to Austin, Waco, Fort Worth and Dallas where it concludes with the SMU Mustangs. Tuesday night the members were guests of the A&M Athletic Department at Little John's Barbecue with an informal get-to-

gether at A&M's Press Room at the Ramada Inn following the dinner. Sports Information Director Spec Gammon was in charge of all activities concerned with the tour while it was at A&M. Wednesday morning the team members were introduced to the tour members at Kyle Field, where pictures and interviews were taken. Coach Ballard then held a conference to discuss the Aggies' chances for the SWC

and a Cotton Bowl bid on January 1. Ballard went down the roster position by position and gave his thoughts on how each man stacked up.
