

Committee Fights Discrimination

AUSTIN (AP)-A Texas commission on Civil Rights has proposed taxes on personal income and business profits as a partial solution to a public school finance system to the commission report which claims discrimination against Mexican-American chil-

The committee's recommendations were released with the commission's report at a news conference Monday.

The report of the commission, an independent bipartisan agency created by Congress in 1957, was the fourth in a series investigating Mexican-American education in the Southwest.

It said the money spent for educating many Mexican-Americans is "three-fifths that spent

The report described Texas' Minimum Foundation Programwhich supplies 96 per cent of state education funds—as a "repressive jumble of provisions and

conditions that do not adequately mittee to advise the U.S. Com- reduce financial disparities between Anglo and Mexican-American districts and insure that significantly less is spent to educate Chicano children than their Anglo counterparts." In addition, the commission said, Texas "has devised an educational finance system by which the amount spent on the schooling of students is a function of district and personal wealth. The end result is that the poor stay poor and those receiving inferior education continue to receive inferior educa-

> The 24-member Texas committee, which is made up of presidential appointees who serve without pay, said Texas "is failing to meet the challenge" of educating minority group pupils. About one-half of all Mexican-Americans and one-third of all blacks drop out of school before completing the 12th grade, the committee said, compared to 15 per cent of Anglos.

It would take an additional \$224 per pupil to bring Texas that all property be taxed at its school expenditures up to the full market value, enactment of national average, the committee said, and an additional \$443 per pupil to place Texas among the top five states. It now ranks

"As the commission's report documents," the committee said, "some predominantly Mexican-American school districts cannot fill all their positions because teachers refuse to work in them.

"The poorer Mexican-American states." districts cannot supplement statesupported salaries to the extent that wealthier Anglo districts and, therefore, lose both the teachers with more education and experience and the increased state aid."

Other than the personal income

Texas committee recommended a tax on the transfer or sale of property and a new state tax agency to handle property taxes and assessments.

Also recommended was that the state assume responsibility for raising revenue for public schools, state aid on the basis of a child's educational need and that Texas raise its average expenditure per pupil to that of the top five

The committee rejected any sales tax increase to finance additional educational costs.
