

on Dean Replaces Lex James At Quarterback

# Changes Made In Aggie Lineup For Tech

 Don Dean will replace senior Lex James this Saturday night in the Aggie lineup against Texas Tech at quarterback. Coach Emory Bellard announced Tuesday at his weekly press conference.

"Don has a lot of command and a lot of poise," Bellard said. "He is inexperienced but mechanically sound as a dollar. He has a great ability to command and direct. This in no way reflects a lack of showing by Lex. It was just something we felt needed to be done."

This announcement eliminates

much anxiety on the part of many Aggie followers that had anticipated the change when Bellard said his workouts would be closed to the public last Monday.

Closed workouts will continue the remainder of the week so the Aggies can be mentally prepared for the opening of the 1972 Southwest Conference race.

Other changes have been made for this week's test.

Freshman Ed Simonini of Las Vegas, Nev., has replaced injured Dennis Carruth at strongside linebacker and Paul Hulin, sophomore from Hobbs, N. M., has been placed at right defensive end re-

placing James Dubcak who quit the squad last week.

Offensively, Ricky Seeker, sophomore from Bay City, has replaced Mike Park at left tackle.

"None of these new replacements have game experience," he said. "All are fighters and any mistakes they make will be going full speed and with aggressiveness."

For the first time since the Wichita State game, the Texas Aggie Wishbone will have its three starters running the ball.

Mark Green, Brad Dusek and Bubba Bean will start against Tech Saturday.

"Bubba is at 100 percent capacity," Bellard said. "Brad is not in as good shape as he could be because he hasn't been able to run until this week. Mark's injury is also 100 percent healed."

What have the Aggies been doing during this off week?

"We went back to fundamentals this week," he said. "This is a big help to our football team and it couldn't have come at a more opportune time."

This week's opponent, Texas Tech, stands with a 3-1 record with the lone loss coming against Texas two weeks ago, 25-20.

"Tech has a real good football

team," he said. "They have a talented offense, great running backs with both speed and power and a fine line."

"Their quarterback (Joe Barnes of Big Lake) is exceptional and Tech is very talented at the skill positions."

"Their defense is a real hard-nosed, tough and aggressive one and no one has been able to move the football consistently against them."

Tech is adept both rushing and passing, which will give the Aggies a double-tough task to accomplish Saturday night.

"We'll have to work on both," he said. "We can't work on just one thing as they can both run and pass excellently."

## Cincinnati, Tigers Stay in Race

**CINCINNATI (AP)**—Ross Grimsley overpowered Pittsburgh with a two-hitter as the Cincinnati Reds crushed the fumbling Pirates 7-1 Tuesday and sent the tense National League playoffs into a fifth and deciding game.

one more victory either today or, if necessary, Thursday to clinch its first World Series berth since 1931 with a 3-0 victory.

The Reds tied the best-of-five series for the National League pennant at 2-2 and set the stage for Wednesday's showdown struggle between opening-game pitchers Steve Blass of Pittsburgh and Cincinnati's Don Gullett.

Coleman made sure the A's didn't get the victory Tuesday. The hard-throwing pitcher worked out of frequent jams, allowing seven hits and pitching with men on base in all but two innings. But his strikeout pitch kept bailing him out of trouble.

Grimsley, a hard-throwing left-hander who pitched the Reds' West Division-clincher this season, allowed both hits to Roberto Clemente—a fourth-inning single and a seventh-inning home run.

His 14 strikeouts broke the playoff record of 12 established by Baltimore's Jim Palmer on Oct. 5, 1970, against Minnesota.

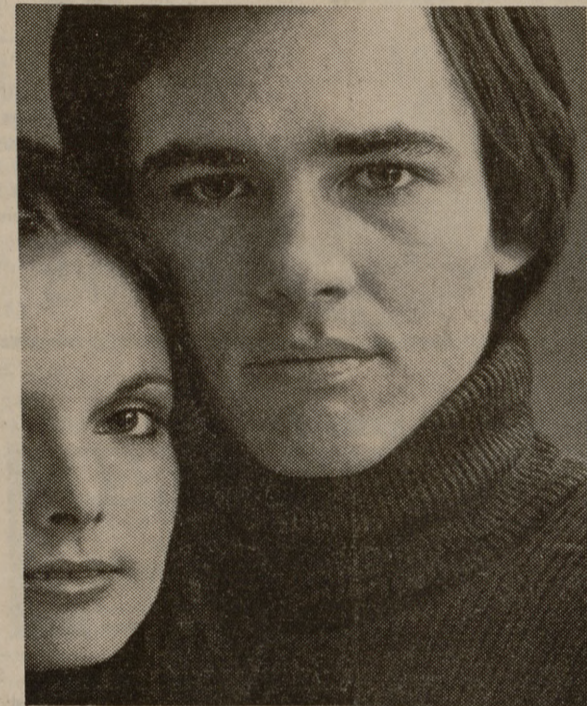
