

# Martial Law Proclaimed In South Korea

SEOUL (AP) — President Chung Hee Park proclaimed martial law Tuesday in South Korea, asserting that political parties could not be trusted to push unification talks with Communist North Korea.

## Jury Indicts UMW Officials

PITTSBURGH (AP)—Two United Mine Workers officials were indicted Tuesday by a federal grand jury here on conspiracy charges in the 1969 murder of UMW insurgent Joseph A. "Jock" Yablonski.

The indictments charged William J. Prater, 53, of LaFollette, Tenn., and Albert Pass, 58, of Middlesboro, Ky., with conspiracy to deprive Yablonski of his rights under the 1870 Civil Rights Act, and maintained that the murder resulted directly from that alleged conspiracy.

Yablonski and his wife and daughter were found shot to death in their nearby Claresville farmhouse Dec. 31, 1969, three weeks after Yablonski lost a bitterly fought election to incumbent W. A. "Tony" Boyle for the union's presidency.

Both Prater and Pass are in federal custody here in lieu of \$200,000 bond each.

In a surprise move, the former four-star general dissolved the National Assembly, suspended parts of the 1962 constitution and clamped censorship on the domestic press. He also closed colleges and universities "for the time being."

He promised to restore constitutional rule by the end of the year "at the latest." It was the third time he has proclaimed martial law since he took power in a bloodless military coup 11 years ago.

In Washington, State Depart-

ment spokesman Charles W. Bray said the United States was "not consulted about the decision and quite obviously" is "not associated with it."

Addressing the nation by radio, Park said he would propose constitutional changes by Oct. 27 and submit them to a referendum a month later. The changes, he said, would permit South Korea to face the transition from years of cold war to the present atmosphere of detente which includes moves toward reunification with North Korea.

Park said his measures would bring South Korea into line with present-day realities and "would be best suited for backing up the active pursuit of the South-North dialogue and for coping successfully with the rapidly changing situation surrounding us."

Immediately after the proclamation, armed troops and armored vehicles moved into position around the parliament building. The one-house National Assembly was in recess and no lawmakers were inside.

South Korea's "changing situ-

ation" includes recent moves toward rapprochement with Communist China by the United States and Japan.

After a quarter-century of hostility, the North and South Korean governments announced agreement in July to seek peaceful reunification and avoid tension on the Korean peninsula. The agreement followed secret contacts between the two governments. Red Cross talks aimed at reuniting families separated by 27-year-old partition of Korea are already under way.

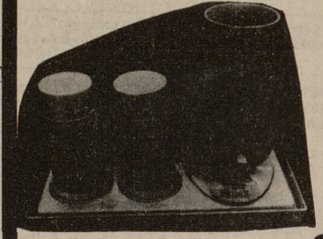

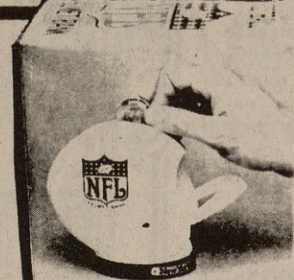
