

Voter Turnout Sets Record

This year's presidential election turnout was a contrast in numbers. An estimated 77.5 million voters showed up at the polls, adding up to the highest turnout in history. But the total represents only 56 per cent of the potential electorate, making it the worst showing in almost a quarter of a century.

Enough new voters were created through the lowering of the voting age to 18 to swell the voting age population by 11.5 million to a total of 140 million. But the turnout for the last five presidential elections averaged 62 per cent, and the last time it slipped below 60 per cent was in 1948 when only 52 per cent turned out to elect Harry Tru-

Most states had record totals this year, but some actually had areas. fewer voters than in 1968. Washington, D. C., whose heavily black voting population gave George McGovern one of his few bright spots in the returns, actually had 41,000 fewer voters than in the last presidential election.
