

# Irish Crisis: Demonstrators March On Parliament

DUBLIN (AP) — The government's plan to smash the outlawed Irish Republican Army plunged Ireland into a political crisis Wednesday. Demonstrators marched on parliament as Prime Minister Jack Lynch told lawmakers the IRA might be planning rocket attacks in the republic.

The march by 2,000 persons on the Dail, or parliament, followed a mass rally in Dublin's Liberty Hall. Speakers at the rally, sponsored by the IRA and its political arm, the Sinn Fein, declared a state of war on the Lynch administration.

Hundreds of police guarded the Dail building as the demonstrators demanded defeat of

Lynch's anti-IRA legislation and release of Sean MacStiofain, the 44-year-old IRA leader.

MacStiofain, sentenced to six months in jail for IRA activities, was reported still critically ill in a military hospital after 11 days

of refusing food. He began to take liquids Tuesday but has vowed a fast to the death unless he is freed.

Lynch, whose proposed legislation would make it easier to convict members of illegal organiza-

tions, told the Dail during heated debate that IRA guerillas "have turned their guns now on the security forces in this state. We have close experience of their bombs."

"They have detonated their

bombs here, within a few hundred yards of this house."

"Will they next turn their rockets on this part of this country?"

"The fact that they have done that in other parts of the country should be sufficient reason for us to take effective action to curb this activity."

Lynch referred to 11 rocket attacks on police and army posts in Northern Ireland over the past two days. MacStiofain's militant IRA Provisional wing is conducting a violent campaign to wrest Protestant-dominated Northern Ireland from British rule and unite it with the overwhelmingly Roman Catholic Republic.

The rally at Liberty Hall heard fiery speeches from Bernadette Devlin, 25-year-old member of the British Parliament, and 52-year-old Maire Drumm. Both women are stalwarts of the Catholic community in the North.

Mrs. Drumm said she had seen MacStiofain Monday and "MacStiofain is on his death bed. I said goodby to him as I never expect to see him alive again."

Then she cried: "We have a murderer in our midst today. We have in fact two of them — Jack Lynch and Justice Minister Desmond O'Malley. And maybe it is appropriate that these two should be murdered at this time."

## Kodak Co. Grants \$3,250 To A&M

A&M has been awarded \$3,250 as part of Eastman Kodak Company's 1972 Educational Aid Program.

The funds were formally presented to President Jack K. Williams by Joe Randolph, industrial relations representative for Texas Eastman Company of Longview.

Under the Kodak program, some 265 institutions of higher education this year are receiving \$1.3 million in unrestricted direct grants, noted Randolph, a 1962 TAMU graduate.

He said the size of each grant is based on the number of graduates from each institution who joined Eastman within five years after graduation.

They are presently completing their fifth year of employment.

TAMU has four graduates meeting the requirements this year. They are Allen Burns of the Kodak Park Division and Juan C. Diaz, Carol M. Howell and Jimmy L. Humphrey, all of Texas Eastman.
