

PARIS (A)-A scheduled secret meeting between Henry A. Kissinger and Le Duc Tho of North Vietnam was mysteriously canceled Tuesday

The U.S. and North Vietnamese delegations announced that the peace negotiators will hold private talks Wednesday.

No reason was given by either side for the cancellation of the meeting, which had been announced by the White House on Monday.

The site for Wednesday's rendezvous remained undisclosed. It will be selected by the Americans in accordance with an agreement reached between the negotiators whereby each side alternately picks the meeting place.

The North Vietnamese first issued word that the meeting was off. The U.S. delegation confirmed this and then shortly after -almost simultaneously with the North Vietnamese-said a meet-

Officials on both sides maintained their tight news backout.

Nixon Administration Moves Pr On Curbing Skyjackings

WASHINGTON (A)-The Nixon administration moved on domestic and foreign fronts Tuesday to curb skyjackings through tightened surveillance at airports and through an agreement with

The domestic program calls for electronic screening of all passengers and inspection of their carryon baggage, plus the posting of armed guards at loading areas, at the expense of airports and

The Volpe plans drew prompt criticism from airport officials' groups who want the federal government to assume full responsibility for security activities.

Secretary of Transportation John A. Volpe announced the promptly challenged security regulations while Secretary of State William P. Rogers disclosed he is submitting to Cuban authorities a hijacking agreement intended to forestall further use of that ity of the airlines and the airport

for hijackers.

Volpe directed the airlines to on to travelers, presumably implement within one month procedures for electronic screening of all passengers and for inspection of all carry-on items accessible to passengers.

He asked also that airport operators submit within 30 days plans for the stationing of armed guards at checkpoints during periods when passengers are boarding. Full implementation of the plans would be required within 60 days.

Benjamin O. Davis, assistant secretary of Transportation, told a news conference that federal funds will be used to acquire the electronic metal-detection equipment in a program which already is underway.


