## UCLA, Maryland Keep Lead In Basketball Poll

 North Carolina State switched places with Marquette Tuesday while UCLA and Maryland continued to play "me and my shadow" in The Associated Press' major-college basketball poll.

North Carolina State, 9-0, moved into third place with 689 points while Marquette, 10-0, dropped to fourth with 656 in balloting by sports writers and sportscasters.

UCLA, 10-0, remained a unanimous first-place choice while Maryland, 9-0, stayed a solid second choice. UCLA got all 47 first-place votes and 940 points while Maryland got 767 points.

Missouri moved from sixth to fifth, exchanging places with Long Beach State, while North Carolina was seventh followed by Minnesota, Vanderbilt and Houston.

The Second Ten was comprised of Providence, San Francisco, Southwestern Louisiana, Alabama, Jacksonville, Indiana, Kansas State, Florida State, St. John's of New York and Louisville.

Kansas State and St. John's were tied for 18th.
