Feared Dea KANO, Nigeria (AP)-A chartered jetliner carrying 202 Moslems home from a pilgrimage to Meccacrashed and burned on the runway of Kano's airport Monday while coming in for a landing in a fog.

Officials said they fear 180 persons perished. They reported 30 survived, all of them severely burned. The plane had a crew of eight. This would make the crash the world's deadliest air disaster in-

volving a single aircraft. One hundred seventy-six persons died in the crash of a Soviet Aeroflot jet near Moscow last Oct. 13. The crash here was the 11th

in little over a year in which 100 or more persons were killed in various parts of the world. The one previous to this was the crash of an Eastern Air Lines

Dr. Zebulon W. White, former associate dean of the Yale School of Forestry, will give two lectures Thursday.


The programs are sponsored by the Forest Science Department.






