As many as 1,150 canvassers were sent to points all over the country; some went thousands of miles from their units. There are currently about 300 canvassers living at home or on the civilian

In the first 18 months of the program, the canvassers were paid only their normal military

As the result of a ruling by the Pentagon's comptroller, the Army decided the canvassers would have to receive the \$25 daily temporary duty pay and travel expenses.

Lt. Col. G. W. Bilderback, a Pentagon administrator of the program, said the added costs forced the Army to cut the number of canvassers at least in half.

Despite the cutback, Bilderback said, more troops are joining specific combat units than ever before. Some 28,000 of the 38,000 recruited so far have signed up since the start of fiscal year 1973 last July 1.


