Summer Storage Ready For Use

A&M students may store belongings on campus for the summer.

Trunks, lamps and boxed items will be stored, for one and a half per cent of declared value of the items, in the University Hospital basement or in Milner Hall storage rooms.

The Agronomy Society will accept storage items from 4:30 to 5:30 p. m. through Friday. On Thursday and Friday, items may also be stored from 11 a. m. to 12 noon.

Small loose items such as radios, typewriters, clothing and books must be boxed and sealed or tied. Bulky articles such as chairs, bicycles and filing cabinets will cost \$1 each for storage. Charges will be paid at time of storage.

Students attending the first summer session only may place articles in storage on July 11. Those planning to attend the second session only can pick up storage July 12.

Items stored all summer and for the second session only must be removed between 3 and 5 p. m. Sept. 1-2.

All residence hall phone service will be terminated May 12.

Housing Manager Allan Madeley said long distance contracts for the 1973 spring semester will be cancelled at the same time.

Summer term contracts will be negotiated at June 4 registration.

Madeley said Schuhmacher hall residents who will remain on campus between the end of the spring semester Saturday and start of the summer term should make arrangements with the General Telephone Co. business office for continuous use of long distance service.
