Chrysler plants across the country and in Canada remained shut as UAW leaders met with committeemen, officers and shop stewards from all Chrysler locals to explain the new three-year con-

Most of the shop stewards who attended Tuesday's union meeting predicted ratification, although some said they were upset that UAW President Leonard E. Woodcock said individual locals could not strike over local issues without headquarters' approval.
